

European Programmes

In the 2007-2013 programming period, cohesion policy was reorganised around three objectives. Objective 1 "convergence", Objective 2 "competitiveness" and Objective 3 "European terriodic cooperation," European terriodic cooperation, which previously came under the Intering Community Initiative programme, has thus become a fully-fielded objective of cohesion policy, thereby signalling the recognition of its importan by the European Inland.

There are three strands to the "European territorial cooperation" objective – cross-bor cooperation, transantional cooperation and interregional cooperation – and is finance by the European Regional Development Fund (EDDP).

The Lisbon Treatly, which came into force in December 2009, reinforced the legitimac, regional and local players (subsidianty) and of the European Union's territorial approacemental cohesions.

According to the Tentionial Agenda 2020, which was approved in May 2011 under Hungary's presidency by the European ministers responsible for spatial planning and tentrotrial development, rethrotial coopenation inflatiers must be focused on loop-tentrotrial development, rethrotial code-inflation inflatiers must be focused on loop-tentrotrial cohesion objectives.
