# The review of the EGTC Regulation (European Grouping for Territorial Cooperation)

By participating in this consultation, you will contribute to the own-initiative opinion "The review of the EGTC Regulation" that the Committee of the Regions will deliver at the beginning of 2011, and to the consequent legislative work of the institutions. Regulation EC No. 1082/2006 on EGTC foresees that by 1 August 2011 the Commission shall forward a report to the European Parliament and the Council on the application of the EGTC Regulation and proposals for amendments, where appropriate.

This consultation is a joint initiative of the Committee of the Regions, the Trio of Presidencies of the Council of the European Union (Spain-Belgium-Hungary), the European Commission and the INTERACT programme. It intends to collect the opinions of Member States, EGTC setups and EGTC under preparation, Local and Regional Authorities and other stakeholders concerning EGTC in the perspective of the review of the Regulation. The consultation focuses mainly on the legislative aspects that should be improved or modified in view of the next revision, and also considers the added value and potentialities of the EGTC.

The results will be presented in Brussels the 6 October 2010 during the 8<sup>th</sup> edition of the Open Days (<u>www.opendays.europa.eu</u>).

EU Member States, EGTC setups and EGTC under preparation, Local and Regional Authorities implementing EGTC and other stakeholders are invited to fill in the below form in any of the EU official languages and summit it by 20 July 2010 the latest.

Art. 4.3 §1: in the facts, the convention and the statutes comply with the most restrictive
provisions applying to the members, even if these provisions do not apply in the country
where the headquarter of the EGTC is located; e.g. an EGTC with Italian regions must
include in the convention an initial 15-year term even if its headquarter is not in Italia.
Art. 4.3 §2: indicative time approval of 3 months is rarely respected, because of the lake of
coordination's mechanisms between States.

- 5.1. What would be the main benefits of setting up an EGTC for the management of European Territorial Cooperation <a href="mainto:programme">programme</a>? What could be disadvantages/risks associated?

**Benefits:** the EGTC helps partners' programme to create an appropriate structure fulfilling the function of programme managing authority: the members are represented and decide in EGTC's organs, they can hire staff and sign contract.

**Risks/disadvantages:** the Community regulation does not define EGTC relations with JTS and the Monitoring Committee, which remain autonomous from the EGTC. The State is both member and supervisory authority of the EGTC.

**5.2.** What would be the main benefits of setting up an EGTC for European Territorial Cooperation <u>project</u> management? What could be disadvantages/risks associated? Max. 250 characters.

**Benefits:** the EGTC allows creating a legal body dedicated to the project with a "tailor-made" functioning. Members are represented and decide in organs. The EGTC may implement the project by itself: it manages the budget, signs contracts and hires its own staff.

**Risks/disadvantages:** future members don't know how much time it will take to create the EGTC, which can compel them to launch the project <u>before</u> the creation of the EGTC. Any change in the partnership or the tasks of the EGTC requires starting again the procedure of creation, which limits any rapid evolution of the project.

5.3. What would be the main benefits of setting up an EGTC for the management of projects co-financed by other EU funding? What could be disadvantages/risks associated?

**Benefits:** the use of the EGTC allows members to benefit from any co-financing corresponding to the partnership and the tasks of the EGTC; they are the same benefits as for an EGTC dedicated to territorial cooperation projects management.

**Risks/disadvantages:** they are the same disadvantages as an EGTC dedicated to dedicated to territorial cooperation projects management.

Benefits:								

**Risks/disadvantages**: Project management: an EGTC can't associate members who fulfill missions of public service with an industrial and commercial activity, as they don't apply public procurement rules (e.g. some public establishments or companies).
