

UniGR as driver of the Greater Region



 Internationalisation at home Developing small-scale partnerships with a territorial dimension

- A multi-site university as a factor of territorial balance
- An attractive asset for the cross-border region
- Close partnership with regional actors
- A cross-border university as actor AND observator of the border region



Challenges for crossborder universities



- Despite geographical proximity, mobility remains a major challenge
- Flexible arrangements to cover extra costs of mobility
- Towards a status of the cross border learner ?
- Create cross-border study programms to meet the needs of the cross-border labour market
- Define concerted cross border policies (crossborder Smart Specialization Strategy – S3)
- Integrate the cross-border dimension into European sectoral programming
